OSTRAVA!!!



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Ostrava has a very strategic location – 10 kilometres south of the Polish border and 50 kilometres west of the Slovakian border. Prague is 360 km away, Brno 170km away, Polish Katowice 90 km away and Vienna just over 310 km away. Four rivers flow through the city – Odra, Ostravice, Opava and Lučina.

Ostrava is one of the greenest cities in Czechia. In addition to numerous large parks and forests, you can also find three nature reserves and four natural monuments here. Natural rarities also include stray boulders of Swedish granite from the days of glaciation. Ostrava is also an important economic centre. Many new jobs have been created in the recent years, some in not very traditional sectors such as the automotive, IT and outsourcing industries.

Rankings show that VŠB – Technical University is among the best universities in central Europe. The University of Ostrava also provides education in a number of interesting fields.

This pocket guide will help you discover Ostrava as a tourist destination with many unique attractions, rich cultural life and wonderful gastronomy.

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GETTING HERE



By car

Ostrava is an important transport hub and a major intersection of the Moravian-Silesian Region. It is connected to a dense network of roads, connecting the cities throughout the agglomeration and neighbouring regions. The backbone of the road network is the D1 motorway, connecting Ostrava to Prague (370 km) or Brno (170 km) while also being connected to the Polish A1

By bus

The central bus station (TRAM and TROLLEY stop "Náměstí Republiky") handles primarily regional, national and international connections, Public transport terminals (Hranečník, Dubina, Svinov - mosty, Sad B. Němcové) are used by passengers on commuter lines.

By train

Rail passengers in Ostrava can use a number of rail stations and stops. The most important are Hlavní nádraží (main station) and Ostrava-Svinov. The main station is located in the city district of Přívoz. from where you can easily get to the city centre. Dolní Vítkovice area and the Zoo. Ostrava-Svinov railwav station is the ideal gateway to the city part Poruba. Passengers can find OSTRAVAINFO !!! tourist info centres at both of these railway stations.

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TRANSPORT IN THE CITY

Public transport

Ostrava transport company (DPO) operates a dense network of tram. bus and trollev lines in Ostrava. An extremely developed suburban transport is also a part of the integrated transport system (ODIS) and you can easily reach other attractive places in the region.

By air

Leoš Janáček International Airport is 25 km away from the city centre. Public transport is ensured by the train lines S4 (Mošnov, Ostrava Airport – Ostrava) and regional bus connections (lines 670 and 333 from the central bus station). Observation Tower of the New City Hall

Ostrava New City Hall, built between the years 1925 and 1930, is the largest city hall complex in Czechia and its 85.6 metres tall observation tower is the tallest city hall tower in the country. The observation deck is located at the height of 73 metres and offers a beautiful view of the entire city, both Moravian-Silesian and Těšín Beskydy mountain range, Oderské hills and Poland. If the weather is good, you can see the mountain range of Hrubý Jeseník with the highest mountain of Moravia – Praděd, as well as the mountaintops of Malá Fatra. You can enjoy the services of a guide who will tell you all about the history and present of the city and can recommend some interesting places to visit in the entire region.





Landek Park

Landek Park contains the largest mining museum in Czechia, located at the Landek hill, near the confluence of rivers Odra and Ostravice. It is also the only place in Ostrava where you can go down into the shafts of former mine Anselm, the oldest mine in Ostrava. Apart from mining expositions, Landek Park also offers expositions of mining rescue, mining machines, history of mine haulage and the history of settlers. The area also includes a parking space for caravans, several sportsgrounds and stylish restaurants and bistros.

Michal Mine

Atmosphere. That is the best word to describe the area of the former Michal coalmine in Michálkovice. You cannot go underground in this museum but you will hardly notice that. The guide will take you through the areas which the miners themselves walked through on their way to work. You will see the chain locker rooms, showers, marking and registration rooms, lamp dispensers and the canteen. You can also get a glimpse of the geologist's office and the infirmary. The exposition is kept in a way that it feels like the miners have only left yesterday. The pride of the museum is a unique and still operational steam engine from 1903.



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Zoo Ostrava

In the last several years, ZOO Ostrava has undergone extensive development. It is the second largest Zoo in Czechia (100Ha) and you can find over 400 species and 4000 animals in a natural forest-like area. Notable animals include elephants, hippos, chimpanzees in the Evolution pavilion or African ungulates in the Safari pavilion. Several botanical routes offer entertainment for flora lovers, who can admire blooming rhododendrons during spring season. There is also an educational centre and a restaurant in the Zoo. Feedings with commentary or the evening tours are the best events to visit.

Silesian Ostrava castle

Ostrava has its own castle as well. It was built in the 13th century on the Silesian bank of the Ostravice river near its confluence with the Lučina river. This former house of lords has sunk by 16 metres due to mining activities and in 2004 it was rebuilt to its present form. There are permanent exhibitions and displays inside the castle and the courtyard and amphitheatre host a large number of cultural and social events throughout the year which are very popular and attract numerous visitors.

The largest Dinopark in Czechia is located near Ostrava. It spreads over two high plateaus and it is a home to many models and attractions. Dozens of audio-visual scenes with robotic models of dinosaurs will excite every visitor. DinoExpress can take you to places amongst the dinosaurs which you would be scared to visit on foot. An active 12m high Mesozoic volcano will take your breath away, children climbing frames, swings, jumping attractions, cable line... National Museum of Agriculture

The Ostrava branch of the National Museum of Agriculture offers expositions dedicated to food and agriculture machines. Tractors, cereal processing machines, forage processing machines – those are just a few of the 40 various machines of different brands and age you can find here. You will also get to know, in an interactive way, everything important about food, get to know the basic types of food and answer questions that are related to food issues. The exposition of agricultural technology and the food depository complement temporary exhibitions, events and lectures.





The Gallery of Fine Arts

The Gallery of Fine Arts in Ostrava was founded in 1952 as a Regional gallery. It is situated in the House of Arts – a historical building from 1926 and one of Ostrava's architectural sights. It is the largest collecting gallery in the Moravian-Silesian region which is visited by more than a hundred thousand art loving visitors every year. The gallery contains over 23 000 artworks and it belongs among the five most notable galleries in Czechia in terms of quality of the collections.

Heart of Ostrava

After visiting the New City Hall Observation Tower 1. head for the Hus park to see the Evangelical Church 2 and St. Elizabeth's chapel. Then continue via Poštovní and Čs. Legií streets to the Cathedral of the Divine Saviour (3) and the Jiří Myron theatre. From here it's only a short walk to the Masaryk Square 4 with Old town hall, now containing the Ostrava Museum. Take a lunch or a coffee break and then continue on the 28. října street to the Antonín Dvořák theatre 5. Would you believe that coal was once mined in these places?

Walk length: approx. 4 km



Ostrava viewpoint

The walk begins in the centre, next to the New City hall . Walk upstream along the Ostravice river to the green footbridge next to the County court. Cross the river and continue towards M. Sýkora bridge. Walk through the Bohumínská street, along the liberation monument in the form of a tank , and continue to the Silesian Ostrava city hall. From there follow the yellow tourist sign to the information sign under the Ema slag heap. Walk along the foot trail through the small forest until you are at the top of Ema from where you can enjoy the view . Afterwards you can follow the signs to the other side of Ema and they will lead you to the Zoo entrance .

Red brick city



The sight of Mirové square already tells you what to expect from Vitkovice. The city hall ①, former factory hotel ② and the Church of St Paul ③ are all built from unplastered red bricks. The bricks are also a foundation of the nursery school ④, the market hall ⑤ and the iconic houses of the Štítová colony ⑥. When New Vítkovice were created, in the 1880s, they provided an unprecedented comfort for all its inhabitants.
